



ICA Uniform Guidelines GIRLS – uniforms must be clean, pressed and free of rips

Bottom Choices:

Classic Navy/Evergreen Plaid*, above the knee

Navy Chino, above the knee

Navy or Khaki Chino (must be this material) pants or shorts

Shoes:

Please wear closed toe shoes – dress, tennis shoes, flats, etc. No slides, crocs or foam shoes

Leggings:

Black leggings under skirt acceptable,

Tops Choices:

Polo **with logo** – long or short sleeve, available at Landsend

Colors: Hunter green, gray, white

Cardigan sweater (zip or button)

Colors: Hunter green, gray, white, navy

Sweatshirt, only at Landsend

Colors: Green, gray

Navy or Khaki Chino (must be this material), pants and shorts acceptable



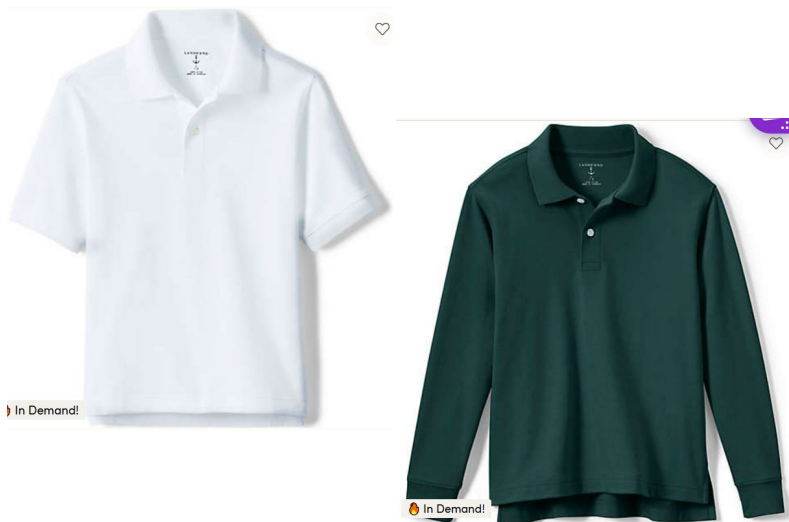
Shoes:

Color: gray

Additional Guidelines

PE/DANCE CLOTHES: Students may change into different clothing for PE or dance class. Students must change back into their school uniform unless it is the last period of the day.

DRESS DOWN DAYS: From time to time students will have a “dress-down” day where the uniform is not required. Parents will receive prior notice about these days. All students are to dress modestly. Lettering and pictures must not be offensive to God or others.

Boys

SHIRTS: Shirts must be opaque with modest necklines. No underclothing may be displayed.

PANTS: Dress slacks, sweat or wind pants, and jeans are acceptable. Pants must be worn with the waist above the hips. Ripped jeans may be worn only if the rips are at or below the fingertips (arms straight down at sides). No pajama bottoms allowed.

SHORTS: Shorts must be at or below fingertip length. Spandex and short shorts are unacceptable. During PE class or for those playing sports (during practices and games only), mid-thigh shorts are acceptable.

Girls

TOPS: Tops (including shirts and blouses) must be opaque with modest necklines. No underclothing may be displayed. Sleeveless blouses and T-shirts are acceptable, but the shoulder must be at least three fingers wide. Shirts must reach below the waistline — no bare stomachs.

DRESSES, SKIRTS, AND PANTS: Dresses, skirts, and skorts are acceptable. Hemlines must be fingertip (arms straight down at side) length or longer even if leggings or tights are worn underneath. Dresses must have modest necklines. Tank-style dresses and jumpers are acceptable only if worn with a blouse or shirt or if the shoulder is at least three fingers wide. Ripped jeans may be worn only if rips are at or below the fingertips (arms straight down at sides). Leggings may be worn as pants, but only with a top that covers 360 degrees at a length at or below the fingertips (arms straight down at sides). No pajama bottoms allowed.

SHORTS: Shorts must be at or below fingertip length. Spandex and short shorts are unacceptable.

SPIRIT DAYS: Students will be notified of special dress-down days the attire required on those days. Please check the calendar in the family portal.

HATS: No caps or hats may be worn in school. Hooded sweatshirts must be worn with the hood down while inside the school.

DRESS-UP DAYS: We require students to dress up for special events such as a Christmas program, speech contest, science fair, concert, or graduation. The school will send special guidelines, if applicable, for these events. Because we want our students to understand that dressing modestly isn't something important only on school days but should be a lifestyle, the dress code applies regardless of occasion or location, including graduation pictures and graduation.

Extra uniforms and clothing will be available at the front office to borrow for students who fail to meet the uniform or dress code.
